Dr. Marwan Sabbagh and Barrow Neurological Institute are recruiting subjects to participate in a Down syndrome research study. The study will collect different types of brain scans, including MRI and PET scans, over time to see how Alzheimer's disease changes the brain. Qualified study participants will receive all study procedures at no cost.

Individuals with Down Syndrome (DS) develop Alzheimer's disease (AD) at a much higher rate as compared to the general population. As such, participating in a clinical trial may help us understand AD and possibly implement ways to prevent AD in the future.
