## SPARK OF AWESOME MOM AWARD

Karla Phillips-Krivickas is the founder of Inclusive Strategies, a national thought leader on education policy and reform, and-most importantly-the proud mother of a 19-year-old son and a 15-year-old daughter with Down syndrome.



Hearing the words "Down syndrome" in the delivery room 15 years ago, changed Karla's life and work. Today she uses her 20 years of experience in state and federal policy to bridge conversations between the general education community, policymakers, and the disability community to passionately advocate for all students.

As a member of the Arizona State Board of Education, Karla works to advance academic achievement for Arizona's students, including those with disabilities. And as the founder of Inclusive Strategies, she partners with public and private education leaders to purposefully include students with disabilities in policy and investment agendas.

Karla previously served as the Senior Director of State Policy at KnowledgeWorks and helped states build education systems that support student-centered learning. Before this, she established ExcelinEd's next generation learning portfolio. Her career in education began at the Goldwater Institute conducting research on charter schools and has included serving as the education policy advisor to the Arizona House of Representatives, the Arizona Governor's Office, and the State Superintendent of Public Instruction.



Karla has also served on the National Down Syndrome Inclusive Education Task Force, Arizona's ABLE Act Oversight Committee, the Arizona Special Education Advisory Panel, and as vice chair of the Arizona Developmental Disabilities Planning Council. Through it all, Karla has passionately advocated for all students especially those with disabilities.

## SPARK OF AWESOME DAD AWARD



Sam is a loving husband and father of three children. His oldest daughter, Jasmine, is 14 years old and has Down syndrome. In receiving the Down syndrome diagnosis for Jasmine at birth, Sam didn't miss a beat.

His love and devotion to her has been unwavering since that moment, both in the day-to-day parenting tasks and in the pursuing big picture possibilities for her future. Sam aggressively researches medical advancements that might affect the future health and well-being of people with Down syndrome, and he keeps his finger on the political pulse, so that he can advocate appropriately toward laws that affect the rights of those with developmental disabilities.

Sam began and now acts as President and CEO of LifeTree, Inc. a company that provides Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) in Arizona to Division of Developmental Disabilities (DDD) Members. Under his leadership, LifeTree has emerged as a well-respected, warm, and competent HCBS Vendor statewide. Providers, Parents, and DDD Support Coordinators seek him out specifically for guidance and assistance. He is a champion of the Parent Provider Program and has helped thousands of Caregivers become qualified as DDD Providers.

Sam is a stellar Article 9 Instructor, recognized repeatedly by attendees of all education levels and backgrounds. His relatable and intelligent way of presenting the course materials has helped caregivers to understand and internalize the psychological principles behind proactively and positively supporting appropriate interventions to deal with challenging behaviors.

Sam is ever-evolving and growing, learning all that he can to create the best possible life for Jasmine, his family, and others whose lives may have similarities to theirs. He will forever be her "Dada" and she is lucky to have such a champion in her court.

The Colten Cowell Foundation gives families one-of-a-kind experiences that are awe-inspiring and deeply meaningful. It's not about a comic book hero, there is only room for one superhero at their crime fighting events, and that is the nominated child.

Every part of the experience is tailor-made to make the child feel like the superhero they are, and for everyone involved to share in moments of great laughter, excitement and wonder without the distraction of the caped crusader.

The experience begins with a limo ride to the 5,000-square-foot Colten Cowell Memorial Crime Fighting Cave, where the superhero is greeted by up to 25 family members and friends. Then the child and family explore the cave - which is filled with blinking, electronic gadgets and gizmos that they are encouraged to touch, a dazzling vintage car collection, and surprises around every corner. But being a superhero isn't just about the fast cars and cool gadgets - it's also about helping those in need. That's why, at the conclusion of the evening, the nominated superhero receives a check to present to the charity of the child's choice.

In the process, children not only learn about the importance of giving, but also experience firsthand how rewarding and downright fun giving can be.

When studying at Ohio State University, Stephanie Anderson found a passion for those with different abilities, specifically Down syndrome. While caring for a young boy with Down syndrome, she began teaching him tennis and fitness. She quickly realized there was a real void in organized tennis and fitness programs dedicated to individuals with Down syndrome. Stephanie and two other leaders took the initiative to make their dreams a reality and held the first Buddy Up Tennis Clinic in December 2008 in Ohio. Since the launch of the program there are now an inspiring 25+ chapters of Buddy Up Tennis nationwide.

A few years after Stephanie moved to the valley, Buddy Up Tennis launched its Phoenix Chapter. Stephanie's husband, Rami Burbar, began as a volunteer. His energy and smile are contagious on and off the court. His passion for fitness and making others laugh proved himself a valuable member of the team. Rami discovered a love for those with all abilities. He serves as a regular Buddy and local leader of Buddy Up Tennis.

Stephanie's passion expanded beyond the tennis court. She now serves individuals with various abilities as a pediatric Speech-Language Pathologist as part of Phoenix Children's Down Syndrome Clinic and Outpatient Rehabilitation. While Stephanie brings the therapist's perspective to the tennis clinic, Rami brings laughter and energy. They are both honored to serve the Down syndrome community and have valued getting to know our amazing DSNetwork families.
